Holt High School marching band gets new uniforms after 26+ years

After 26 years and over 4,500 students later, the Holt Ram Marching Band will perform in brand new marching band uniforms. The Holt Band Boosters Marching Forward 2021 fundraising campaign and other funding activities helped support the purchase of over 200 marching band uniforms for the 2021 Marching Band Season.

Major funding support also came from the Holt Public School District which agreed to fund up to 50% of the \$100,000 funding necessary to purchase the uniforms with the Band Boosters needing to match the remain-

On Sept. 17, the Holt Ram Marching Band will take the field for the first time in their new uniforms during the pregame of the football game between the Holt Rams and their rival Dewitt, defending state champions.

The halftime show of this game features the annual light show with stunior high bands.

The Marching Forward 2021 fundraising campaign and our other fundraising activities represented a vision the Boosters have had for a number of years to replace the uniforms so many marching band students have proudly worn the past 26 years," said Dennis Marvin, President of the Holt Band Boosters. "In addition to the Marching Forward campaign and other creative fundraising, we are especially grateful to the Holt Public School District Board of Directors and Superintendent Dr. David Hornak for its financial backing to make our vision a reality."

The Boosters campaign included outreach to area companies, businesses, and individuals for some of its funding with Delhi Township based Simas Dramas Law Firm providing the single largest business contribution along with a number of individual contributors. In addition, the Boosters also recycled the old uniforms and made pillows and tote

dents from both the high school and ju- bags for sale to band alumni and other supporters. They also sold a number of full uniforms or pieces to individuals.

"As Band Director for over 16 years, I am personally excited to have our outstanding student performers in new uniforms," said Michael Emerson. "I have shared the Boosters vision for outfitting our students with new uniforms, but I am also grateful to them for not only leading the funding raising efforts to make it possible, but also for the many years this outstanding volunteer organization has supported the band by maintaining the uniforms we wore for over 26 years," he said.

The Holt High School Marching Band includes over 180 students from grades 9-12. The Holt Ram Marching Band performs at high school football games including the annual half-time light show, marches in the Holt and Dimondale Memorial Day parades, as well as the Silver Bells parade in Lansing, and at Marching Band exhibitions in Chelsea and Grand Ledge.
